Peoples Mobilisation to Reclaim Peoples Rights over TNCs, Corporate Profits and impunity

Title of the event	Peoples Mobilisation to Reclaim Peoples Rights over TNCs, Corporate Profits and impunity

Brief summary & narrative report of the Activity	During the period October 11-19 at the UN Human Rights Council in Geneva, AEPF - Asian and European organisations were among the more than 100 organisations from affected communities, social movements, womens' organisations, trade unions, indigenous peoples, migrant organisations, parliamentarians participating in the activities. The mobilisation for the week, also brought together delegations from Latin America and Africa in which all contributed to generate a dynamic and constructive environment for the debate on the Revised first Draft of the Treaty on TNCs and Human Rights.
	 AEPF participants – specific advocacy meetings with Indonesia, Philippines, Malaysia, China, India and with the the representative of the EEAS, representing the EU and Member States – reflected on the floor of the UNHRC when these states intervened in the debate. The overall process has reached a stable mode (96 governments in attendance) and negotiations have reached a new point of maturity and strength with approximately 30 states participating substantively with concrete text proposals. Civil society participation was active with regular interventions in the programme of work. However, the participation of CSOs was questioned by a number of states—but successfully defended by most states, including the European Union. The debate alerted on the drift of the Treaty text moving away from some key advocacies of civil society and the Global Campaign. This focuses attention to the articulation on key content of the Treaty in the work going forward – primacy of human rights; instruments of enforcement; and the rights of affected communities and their effective access to justice.
