



China's role in international investment law and policy



- BITs: China has BITs with all EU MS except Ireland; 127 worldwide (107 in force)
- WTO: Very active on Investment Facilitation
- Regionals: Regional Comprehensive
 Economic Partnership (RCEP)

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Priority areas in EU-China investment negotiations



- Market access, investment liberalization
- Investment protection
- "Domestic regulation"
- Sustainable development, labor & environment
- Dispute settlement

Investment liberalization and market access



- Absolute market access (positive list): prohibition of quotas, joint ventures, etc.
- Relative market access: NT, MFN (negative list, reservations):
 EU: establishment; CN: establishment, acquisition, expansion
- Prohibition of performance requirements: Local content, R&D, etc
- "Domestic regulation": licensing, permitting, transparency, administrative processes
- Dispute settlement: ISDS or no ISDS?



Investment protection

- Investment protection standards
 - Expropriation
 - FET: Listing v CIL approach
 - Umbrella clause (CN)
 - Free capital transfer
 - ISDS
- 10 cases brought by investors from China (including HK)
- 5 ISDS cases brought against China
